At the teak bar or around the fire pit, “Cocktail Hour” guests can order from a list of distinguished wines and Champagnes by the glass, or from a menu of signature cocktails – all offered at half-price. The Frozen Lemonade, with Ultimat Vodka, Cointreau and fresh citrus juices blended with ice and pickled lemon rind, will cool guests off on even the warmest day. The Speckled Jalapeño Margarita, made with Patrón Reposado Tequila, fresh citrus juices and Grand Marnier, features the kick of muddled jalapeño pepper. The Blackberry Caipirinha refreshes with its blend of Cachaça Rum, muddled blackberries, thyme, lemon juice and cane sugar. Fresh fruit smoothies and lemonade are also available.

Guests can order appetizers that range from Rolled Hamachi Carpaccio with Basil, Lemon, Ponzu Pearls, Ginger and Marinated Cucumbers, to Dungeness Crab Cake with Green Mango, Green Papaya and Marinated Daikon Radish. For those inclined to stay for dinner, The Roof Garden menu tempts with dishes such as Fish Tacos with Mango “Pico de Gallo,” Cilantro and Guacamole;
