GUEST ROOMS AND SUITES AT THE PENINSULA SHANGHAI

The ultimate in luxury, glamour and state-of-the-art facilities

Opening in late 2009, the ninth property in The Peninsula Hotels' portfolio is superbly located on the historic Bund in the very heart of Shanghai, on the banks of the Huangpu River. The Peninsula Shanghai offers commanding city and garden views, luxurious comfort, sophisticated facilities, extraordinary dining options and the legendary Peninsula service.

A homage to Shanghai in the 1920s and 1930s, The Peninsula Shanghai recreates the look and feel of this glamorous era when Shanghai was feted as "The Paris of the East", yet also offers the latest in state-of-the-art technology, services and amenities.

Shanghai is celebrated for its glorious Art Deco architecture, and thus The Peninsula Shanghai's design brief was dictated by this historic architectural movement from the 1920s and 30s in order to blend in with its neighbours on the Bund. New York-based architect David Beer, formerly of BBG/Architects, and Paris-based interior designer Pierre-Yves Rochon of PYR pay tribute to the influences and reference of the Art Deco movement with a modern interpretation inspired by Art Deco – simplified, yet using many of the same materials and design motifs.

The Peninsula Shanghai's 235 guestrooms (including 55 suites) are amongst the largest in Shanghai, with a typical Deluxe Guestroom being 55 sq m (600 sq ft), and most featuring stunning views of Pudong, the Huangpu River, the Bund or the gardens of the former British Consulate. The rooms are elegantly designed to provide luxurious comfort and features, with Art Deco-inspired interiors seamlessly blending traditional Peninsula standards of comfort and state-of-the-art technology with elements of Chinese heritage. Exotic woods, imported stones, black lacquer, carved glass and accents of polished chrome combine to create a luxurious environment where design meets functionality, and Art Deco meets technology.

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In tones of celadon or cerulean blue and ivory, the interior design incorporates a number of traditional materials used in Shanghai in the 1920s – the rich figures of mahogany and ebony for the loose furniture and millwork, and the dramatic contrasts of black Noir St Laurent and off-white St Talino stones. Carpets are 100% wool and hand-tufted. Polished chrome Art Deco details throughout the room, such as the chandeliers and decorative lamp stands, contrast with Chinese accents, including hand-painted panels on the black lacquer TV cabinet, providing a unique and distinctive sense of place – a signature Peninsula feature in each property around the world.

A typical guest room is sub-divided into discreet elements of bedroom, bathroom and dressing room. A “privacy door” allows the bedroom to be closed off from the rest of the room, creating the sense of privacy of a suite in a typical room.

The guestroom’s opaque glass door opens to reveal interior space that combines an open plan living room and work area with stunning views of Pudong, the Huangpu River, the Bund or the gardens of the former British Consulate.

The spacious, self-contained dressing room and walk-in closet includes a seated dressing table, the signature Peninsula valet box for discreet pick-up and delivery of polished shoes, laundry and dry-cleaning, a large electronic safe, a luggage rack, for two suitcases, Internet radio, weather display panel, and a “nail dryer. “

Typical guestroom features also include complimentary wireless high-speed Internet access, a bedside panel with remote control capabilities to adjust the room environment with a touch of a button, interfaced Entertainment Centre with a 46” LCD television and enhanced international television programming, CD/DVD players with 5.1 sound bar and Internet radio, four-in-one fax/printer/scanner/photocopier machine, dual voltage outlets (110V/220V), individual thermostat and humidity control and a complete Nutrition Centre with a fully stocked mini-bar, Nespresso™ coffee machine and tea-making facilities.

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The impressive lacquer working desk is complete with modern-day conveniences – high-speed Internet access, international Internet radio, weather panel, iPod docking station and more.

The large cream marble bathroom is complete with double vanity, hands-free telephone function, mood lighting, TV/radio, separate bath and rain shower, accented by carved opaque glass panels and an intricate floral carving above the bathtub, hand-carved in limestone to a French design. A spa button beside the bathtub dims the lights, activates the “Do Not Disturb” function on the phone and doorbell and switches on soothing music for relaxation while watching television or simply luxuriating in the tub.

Suites

A range of suites offers guests a wide selection of more spacious accommodations, while The Palace, Majestic and Astor House Hotels, The Peninsula Shanghai’s three premier suites named after the hotel’s forebears, offer unique attributes to ensure they become Shanghai’s preferred locations for glamour and luxury.

The Palace Suite features a magnificent 1,000 sq m (11,000 sq ft) wrap-around terrace - ideal for entertaining, while the Astor Suite’s private terrace features its own whirlpool bath with both suites offering stunning views over The Huangpu River and Pudong skyline. The hotel’s top suite, The Peninsula Suite, offers a glamorous double-height living space and balcony, with views over the historic Bund, the Huangpu River and the Pudong skyline.

Room and Suite features include :

- Marble bathroom with double vanity, telephone with “hands-free” function, mood lighting, TV/radio, separate bath and rain shower.
- Spacious self-contained dressing room with the signature Peninsula valet box for shoe-polishing and laundry services, radio, weather panel and nail dryer

- Bedside panel with remote control capabilities to adjust the in-room environment with the touch of a button.

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- Nutrition Centre, with fully stocked mini-bar, Nespresso™ coffee machine and tea-making facilities

- Private multi-functional fax machine with printer
- In-room EISafe
- Dual voltage electrical sockets 110V/220V
- Individual thermostat and humidity control

Superior Room

Elegantly furnished, Superior Rooms range from 54-67 sq m (581 – 721 sq ft) and feature king beds. Enjoying city views, guestrooms include a comfortable sitting area, large marble bathroom and a work area.

Deluxe Room

Offering the same comfort and benefits as the Superior Room, Deluxe Rooms measure from 54 – 67 sq m (581 – 721 sq ft) with king, Hollywood king, queen or twin beds, a separate dressing area and views over the gardens of the former British Consulate, the Huangpu River or the Bund.

Junior Suite

From 71 – 89 sq m (764 – 958 sq ft) and with expansive views over the Bund and across the Huangpu River to Pudong, Junior Suites offer a spacious bedroom and living environment, with a fully contained dressing room and marble bathroom.

Executive Suite

Lavish, well-appointed and with views of the gardens of the former British Consulate, the Executive Suite measures 90 – 94 sq m (958 – 1,012 sq ft) with a king bed. The suite features a separate living room, dressing room, marble bathroom, executive work desk and guest powder room. This stylish suite can also connect with a Deluxe Room for additional comfort.

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Deluxe Suite

Measuring from 105 – 110 sq m (1,130 – 1,184 sq ft) with a king bed or Hollywood twin bedded option, the Deluxe Suite features magnificent views over the Bund, the gardens of the former British Consulate or the Huangpu River to Pudong beyond. The suite offers a separate living/dining room with a dining table for four, an executive writing desk and a fireplace, dressing room, deluxe marble bathroom and a guest powder room

Grand Deluxe Suite

Measuring 120 – 125 sq m (1,292 – 1,345 sq ft) with a king or Hollywood twin beds, the Grand Deluxe Suite enjoys separate living and dining areas with a fireplace, a dressing room, deluxe marble bathroom, executive writing desk, guest powder room and panoramic views of the former British Consulate gardens, the Bund and the Huangpu River. The suite can also connect to a Deluxe Room for added convenience.

The Astor Suite

Offering the same comfort and benefits as the Grand Deluxe Suite, yet specifically designed for private indulgence or entertaining friends for cocktails or dinner, this 116 sq m (1249 sq ft) suite also features a 115 sq m (1,238 sq ft) terrace with a private whirlpool tub and stunning views over the Bund and the Huangpu River. A Junior Suite can connect with this suite if required.

The Majestic Suite

For unsurpassed style and space, and measuring 250 sq m (2,691 sq ft), the Majestic Suite offers magnificent views over the Huangpu River to Pudong beyond and features an impressive entrance, grand king bedroom (convertible to a twin room) with a whirlpool bath tub in the master bathroom, an inviting two-storey high living and dining room complete with a working fireplace, balcony, study, guest powder room and kitchen. This suite can connect with a Deluxe Room for additional accommodation needs.

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The Palace Suite

The pièce de résistance of this spacious 306 sq m (3,294 sq ft) suite is its enormous 1,090 sq m (11,733 sq ft) wrap-around terrace for entertaining in style, with spectacular views along the Bund and across the Huangpu River to Pudong and beyond. This unique space is the largest private terrace on the Bund, and also features a marquee for all-weather entertaining. Facilities in the suite include a large pantry, kitchen and preparation area, with a working fireplace in the living room.

The Peninsula Suite

The height of luxury and the ideal venue for private entertaining, The Peninsula Suite measures 400 sq m (4,305 sq ft) and offers breathtaking views along the Bund and to Pudong across the Huangpu River. This ultimate two-bedroom suite features a two-storey grand dining room with a balcony, living room with a working fireplace, study, guest powder room, private gym and a fully-equipped kitchen and pantry. The master bedroom has an oversized marble bathroom including a whirlpool bath tub and natural daylight. The Suite includes a second bedroom, and can connect with a Deluxe Room should a third bedroom be required.
