**“THE FOREMOST GOOD FORTUNE” BOOK TOUR
SUPPORTED BY THE PENINSULA HOTELS’
NEW BREAST CANCER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN**

The Peninsula Hotels will launch a new groupwide breast cancer awareness- and fund-raising initiative later this year to coincide with the global Breast Health Awareness Month in October. As part of this initiative, the three Peninsula hotels in China – Hong Kong, Shanghai and Beijing - are hosting award-winning American author Susan Conley as she embarks on a tour of China this summer to celebrate the launch of her critically acclaimed memoir *The Foremost Good Fortune*.

The Foremost Good Fortune (Knopf 2011) chronicles the journey Susan and her family took in 2007, when they relocated to Beijing for two and a half years. It is a cross-cultural odyssey through contemporary China, an account of the often strange realities of expat life, and a compelling story of motherhood and Susan’s experiences with breast cancer – she was diagnosed soon after arriving in Beijing.

The memoir has been receiving significant acclaim since its release in February, 2011. *O, The Oprah Magazine* listed the memoir as a Top Ten Pick for February, *Slate Magazine* chose it as "Book of the Week" in March, and *The Washington Post* called it "a beautiful book about China and cancer and how to be an authentic, courageous human being." Reviewers at many publications including *The Boston Globe*, *The San Francisco Chronicle* and *The Telegraph* (UK), have loudly concurred.

The tour begins with a literary event at the Ullens Center for Contemporary Art in Beijing on June 12th, and then moves through a series of literary lunches, high teas and readings in Beijing, Hong Kong and Shanghai. Events in Hong Kong will benefit The Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation, The Peninsula Hong Kong’s designated partner.
