The hotel offers a blend of the best Eastern and Western hospitality in an atmosphere of classical grandeur and timeless elegance. Centrally located in Tsim Sha Tsui, one of the most vibrant art and cultural, shopping, dining and entertainment areas of the city, the hotel is within easy access of the prime business and landmark attractions including Hong Kong Museum of Art, M+ and Hong Kong Palace Museum. A stay at The Peninsula Hong Kong enables guests to re-live the

ACCOMMODATION

The Peninsula Hong Kong comprises the heritage building and the tower building, featuring 297 elegantly designed guest rooms which include 53 suites. All guest rooms showcase the finest details and craftsmanship complemented by thoughtful layout and facilities such as an entry foyer, spacious luggage area, valet service box, fully-customised interactive digital tablets, plus seamless Wi-Fi connectivity and wireless charging. The hotel features two themed suites, the historic Marco Polo Suite and the stately Peninsula Suite with an area of 210 square metres (2,260 square feet) and 377 square metres (4,058 square feet) respectively.

The venue can be partitioned into three separate rooms. Along with the chandeliered foyer and adjacent venues, Nathan Room, The Golden Pen and The Library, the entire space can be fully utilised and is ideal for conferences requiring breakout rooms or gala dinners with different programmes. The ornate, gilded décor of Salisbury Room provides the perfect setting for elegant yet intimate corporate or social functions.

The Golden Pen is ideal for small meetings and can be used for breakout or as a multi-purpose venue for larger functions occupying the entire Mezzanine 2.

Hankow I and II

The contemporary design and lighting along with a foyer featuring stylish built-in coffee stations make Hankow I and II a popular choice for meetings and trainings located on the 6th floor. These spaces are accessible via hotel lifts which connect to all other venues and facilities at the hotel or via a separate office tower lift with direct street access, making it ideal for exhibitions or functions with a flow of participants.

The Garden Suite is a penthouse venue perched on the top floor of the hotel's heritage building, where guests can enjoy spectacular vistas of the famous hotel façade, forecourt fountain and the Victoria Harbour. The venue comprises an indoor area with floor-to-ceiling windows and a spacious open-air terrace overlooking the harbour. The indoor area is perfect for meetings or seated dinners, whilst the terrace presents a magnificent setting for themed coffee breaks or pre-dinner cocktails.

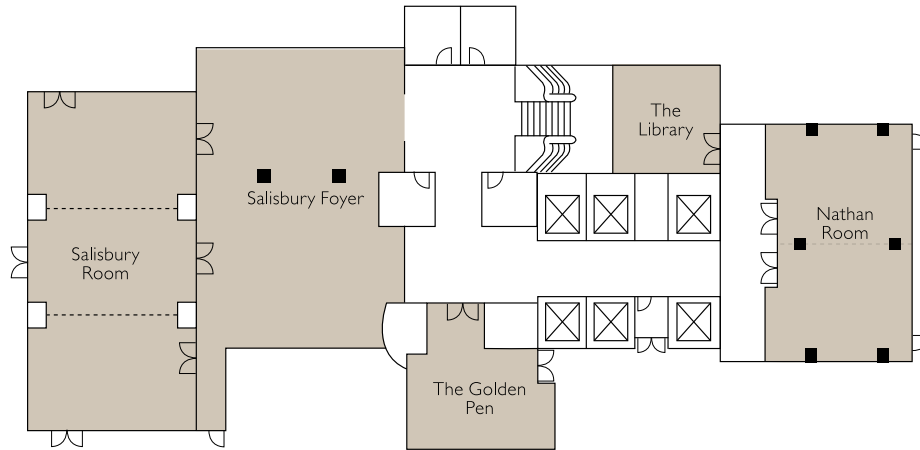


Hankow II

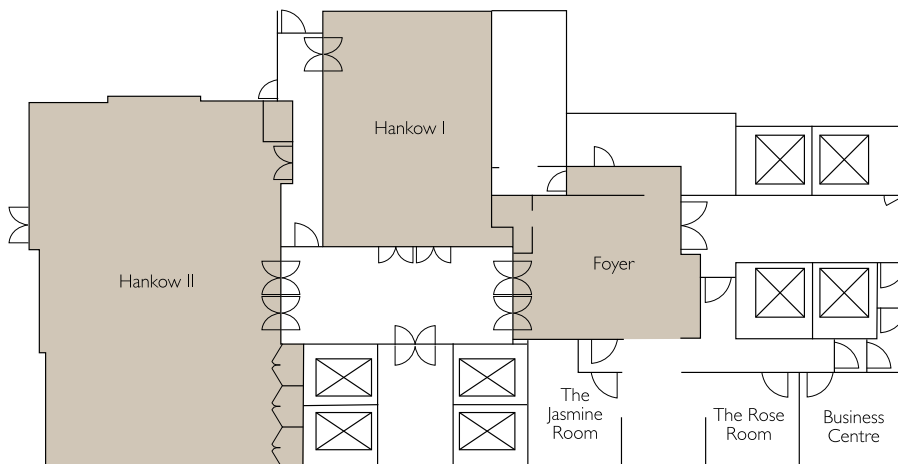

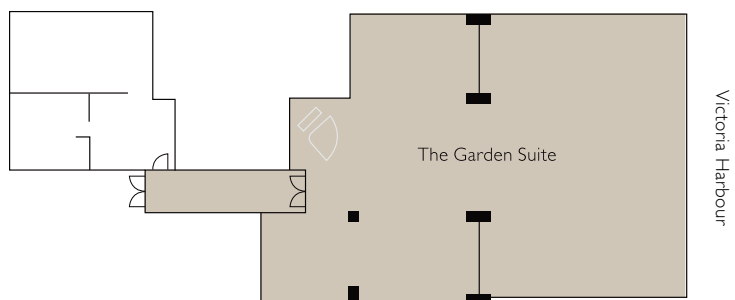

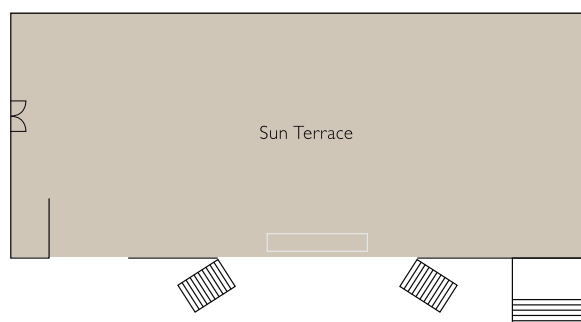

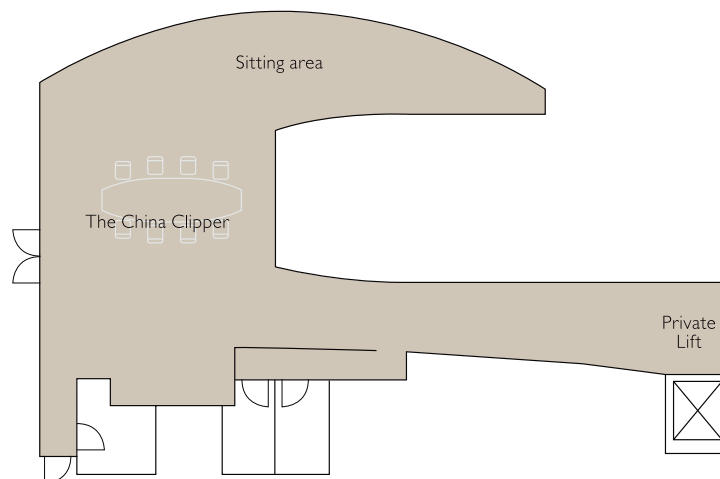

THE PENINSULA ACADEMY

The Peninsula Academy offers a collection of bespoke programmes for both adults and children. With the perfect balance of lifestyle and culture, the programmes have been specifically designed to give insight into this ever-changing and dynamic city.

- *Flight of Fancy*

The Peninsula Hong Kong is the only hotel in the city with its own twin helipads, offering transfer services to and from the airport and for flightseeing tours. This unforgettable air journey flies

over Hong Kong's breathtaking UNESCO-listed GeoPark. With commentary provided by an expert guide, guests enjoy a rare opportunity to observe and learn about the history and distinctive coastal formations of the unique Sai Kung Volcanic Rock Region.

- *Tracks of Light and History*

One of the city's most emblematic sights for over a century is the Hong Kong tram. Affectionately named the "ding ding" because of the distinctive bell, the trams have ferried passengers across the northern part of Hong Kong Island since 1904. A bespoke Circus Tram Academy experience offers visitors the chance to explore Hong Kong from the plush comfort of a unique, custom-designed tram created by local start-up Circus, in association with Hong Kong Tramways. Guests can learn about the city's early development, eye-catching

architecture and heritage sites whilst enjoying local delicacies and chilled Champagne en route.

- *Art of "Touching the Heart"*

This once-in-a-lifetime experience goes back of house for a dim sum making master class. Guests learn the history of these cherished Cantonese delicacies followed by a hands-on session in the kitchen. A professional photographer will document the fun with a series of candid shots. At the end of the journey, guests can relax and taste their own savoury dim sum delights and Chinese desserts.

- *Go with the Flow*

Feng Shui is the timeless art of positioning objects and buildings to enhance life's natural destiny. Guests will learn the foundational theory of "chi" which is the cosmic force that exists between objects, and gain practical advice for arranging their home interior to enhance the harmony of life.
