

The hotel has continued to receive these coveted awards since 2002.

Prior to joining The Peninsula Hotels, Ms. Razumich-Zec held management positions at several notable hotels in both Chicago and New York, including Managing Director and Hotel Manager at The New York Palace Hotel, and Resident Manager at The Palmer House Hilton in Chicago.
