THE HOTEL

Set along the banks of the Chao Phraya River, also known as the "River of the Kings" in the stunning Thonburi district, home to several riverside temples, The Peninsula Bangkok houses exquisite private suites in a Thai colonial-style building. Guests are welcomed to traditional treatments based on European and Asian philosophies, seamlessly combined with modern comforts. A delicious array of Thai and International cuisines is served in beautifully designed

riverfront restaurants. Guests seeking to explore Bangkok can board carefully restored rice barges to cross the river from The Peninsula Pier Lounge to the BTS Skytrain Saphan Taksin Station and ICONSIAM shopping mall.

ACCOMMODATION

The Peninsula Bangkok's 370 elegantly appointed guest rooms are some of the most spacious in the city, with an average size of 46 square metres (495 square feet). All offer views over the Chao

Phraya River. Rooming options include 63 plush suites, as well as two palatial, ultra-luxurious suites: the 330-square-metre (3,552-square-foot), two storey Duplex Suite which features a double-height sitting room and private landscaped terraces on each floor; and the 364-square- metre (3,918-square-foot) Peninsula Suite with private access to the helipad. Luxurious guest rooms have separate sleeping and living areas and magnificent marble bathrooms.





FLOOR PLANS


LOBBY FLOOR







FLOOR PLANS

LOBBY FLOOR






SECOND FLOOR
